Dog Friendly Policy

Well behaved dogs are very welcome here at Smallshaw Cottages, but in order to continue to accept pets here we do ask that the following be adhered to during your stay. Details on how many dogs you are bringing must be supplied on booking form, we have recently been compelled to restrict this to a maximum of two dogs per cottage. The relevant cost must be paid, there is a £30 charge per pet.

Dogs must not be allowed upstairs or on any furniture in any property. Please do bring all appropriate bedding for your pet and protective covers should you think your dog may be tempted to try to get onto the furniture. In the unlikely event that there is an accident whilst in the cottage, please do let us know immediately so we may apply the appropriate action to remove the stain. After departure if we should find any damage as a result of the dog/ dogs having been in the cottage, this must be paid for as per our terms and conditions which is if dogs have been found to have been upstairs/ on furniture or stained the carpets a retrospective charge of £50 will be applied.

Whilst outside, please clean up after your pet at all times. They must be kept under strict control and whilst in our grounds be kept on a lead at all times. Dogs must not be let out unattended. We do have a large garden area but it not enclosed.

Within our digital brochure there is a map showing local walks from the cottages, please do respect the local farmer's livestock and keep dogs on leads where indicated. Also within the brochure there is a list of pubs/ restaurants that are dog friendly in the area. It is not possible to walk through any of the other fields surrounding the cottages.

We look forward to welcoming you here with your favourite four legged friends. One thing we can assure you of, with all the walks in the area, they will go home one very happy but exhausted pet.
